# Operator Fee Levels

**Applicant shall be an enterprise or individual which owns or operates Canadian-registered aircraft as an aid to the conduct of their business.**

*Membership Fees are Based on Canadian registered aircraft.*

Fee Level	Aircraft Type	Annual Fee
<b>1/2</b>	One or more turboprop aircraft Under 12,500 lbs.	\$650
<b>3</b>	One turboprop aircraft 12,500 lbs. and over	\$2,500
<b>4</b>	One turbojet aircraft under 15,000 lbs.	\$2,500
<b>5</b>	One turbojet aircraft 15,000 lbs. to 30,000 lbs.	\$3,500
<b>6</b>	One turbojet aircraft over 30,000 lbs.	\$5,000
<b>7</b>	Two or more aircraft 12,500 lbs. and over	\$5,000

*Applicable taxes extra*

*\*\*Includes helicopters. All weights are Max Takeoff Weight (MTOW)*

## Pro-rated Fees

CBAA membership fees are based on the date the **NEW** application is received. Your invoice will reflect the applicable reduction.

### Pro-rating Scales (For New Members only):
